The Massachusetts Chapter of Associated Builders and Contractors is the largest construction trade association in the Commonwealth, representing over 470 local general contractor, subcontractor, and supplier and associate companies. These companies employ more than 20,000 workers throughout Massachusetts.

ABC is committed to fulfilling its founders' mission of promoting and advancing an open and competitive construction industry. ABC member companies subscribe to the merit shop philosophy that all construction contracts, both public and private, should be awarded to the lowest responsible bidder, regardless of labor affiliation. This philosophy provides construction buyers, taxpayers and consumers with the most value for their construction dollar and ensures equal work opportunities for all of the state's construction workers, 80 percent of whom have chosen not to join a union.

ABC contractors realize their employees are their most valuable resource. ABC members offer their employees highly competitive wage and benefit packages. According to Personnel Administration Services, 90 percent of open shop contractors provide health insurance for their workers. In addition, the firm reports that a majority of open shops also provide pension and profit sharing plans, with many providing bonus plans as well.

ABC contractors and their employees have worked in harmony with union contractors and workers on hundreds of projects throughout Massachusetts. ABC respects the unions' right to exist and to promote the interests of their membership.

ABC offers a complete range of services to its member companies, including a full menu of educational programs. ABC's education and training affiliate, the Gould Construction Institute, is a fully-licensed private school that provides quality apprenticeship, craft and management training utilizing the acclaimed "Contrens" curriculum. ABC's popular Excellence in Construction Awards program annually recognizes "the best of the best" in open shop construction and has become one of the industry's preeminent honors. ABC also provides comprehensive safety and legal training and services to members firms. With a monthly newsletter and quarterly magazine, ABC keeps its members informed of industry news.

ABC provides strong legislative representation to its members and encourages its members to get involved in the process. ABC's governmental priority is to promote the interests of the construction industry and its employees, while ensuring a level playing field and equal access and opportunity for all. ABC strongly opposes any public policies that seek to make labor affiliation a condition of awarding construction contracts.

LICENSED: The Gould Construction Institute (GCI) is fully licensed by the Massachusetts Division of Professional Licensure, Office of Private Occupational School Education.

APPROVALS: GCI is approved by the Department of Labor, Office of Apprenticeship; Division of Professional Licensure and Office of Public Safety and Inspections; Board of State Examiners of Electricians; Board of State of Examiners of Plumbers and Gas Fitters; Board of Examiners of Sheet Metal Workers and the Bureau of Pipefitters, Refrigeration Technicians and Sprinklerfitters.

INSTRUCTION: Provided by State approved trade instructors and industry professionals.

Companies and employees may participate in a state-approved apprenticeship program and utilize GCI courses to fulfill related instruction requirements.
